About Look Good Feel Better:

For the past two decades, the Personal Care Products Council Foundation, supported by the cosmetics industry, the American Cancer Society and the Professional Beauty Association, has worked to give confidence to people undergoing cancer treatment through the **Look Good Feel Better** program.

Founded more than 23 years ago, the Look Good Feel Better program has helped more than 1.2 million people across the U.S. and in 24 countries around the world regain confidence during cancer treatment by helping them to cope with the appearance side effects of cancer treatment. Workshops are FREE, available in all 50 states, and staffed by local expert volunteers that offer lessons in how to apply cosmetics and hair accessories that help address the changes in skin and hair loss that often accompany cancer treatment, as well as tips on wardrobe/styling to help mask weight changes, surgical alterations, and other changes.

Look Good Feel Better is dedicated to changing the way people with cancer approach their disease, reminding them that they are beautiful inside AND out. The program helps women regain confidence some normalcy in a life that is by no means normal.

- ✓ Look Good Feel Better got its official start in 1989. The last **23** years have been full of help and hope.
- √ 800,000 people with cancer have been helped by the Look Good Feel Better program in the United States alone.
- ✓ More than 1,200,000 people have been helped around the world.
- ✓ Each year more than **16,000** Look Good Feel Better workshops are held in nearly **2,700** locations from coast-to-coast.
- ✓ More than 14,500 volunteers across the country donate more than 225,000 hours to Look Good Feel Better every year.
- ✓ Globally, more than **20,400** volunteers donate their time and talents to the program.
- ✓ In 2012, Look Good Feel Better expects to provide more than **16,000** free workshops nationwide that will reach an estimated **50,000** women.
- ✓ Look Good Feel Better is supported by **262** companies, most of whom are affiliated with the cosmetics industry, who provide financial, product and in-kind donations.
- ✓ The Personal Care Products Council Foundation, through support from the cosmetics industry, provides nearly \$2,000,000 annually in financial support to Look Good Feel Better.
- ✓ Each year, the cosmetics industry donates approximately **750,000** pieces of cosmetics and skin care products, valued at approximately **\$7,500,000**.

- ✓ Look Good Feel Better programs are available in all **50** states, and the District of Columbia.
- ✓ Outside the United States, **24** countries also offer Look Good Feel Better programs, including Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Columbia, Denmark, Equador, France, Germany, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Singapore, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, the United Kingdom, and Uruguay, with more being added soon.
